1 Minor Program

MOT (Management of Technology)

Lectures on MOT to learn how to evolve research and development into commercialization, and how to promote the creation of innovation.

Establishment of New Department and Course

Establishment of new department and course for specialized education in metal engineering to develop specialists possessing knowledge and skills, from raw materials to processing and business development.

English Language Education
